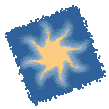

Summer Reading at the Library!

Come one, come all, and experience the joys of reading! Whether you are 1 or 100, the Perkiomen Valley Library has a reading club that is tailored to fit you. Participants can register and log books online via our website (www.pvlibrary.net) by clicking on the large Summer Reading Club icon or with a paper form, available at the Circulation Desk. (Forms need to be returned to the library. As prizes are awarded throughout the summer, return logs often!)

Children, birth through 5th grade: Catch the Reading Bug– For every 10 books you read or listen to (including the ones read at our summer storytimes!), pick from our prize basket, which includes goodies like free water ice from Rita's. Read 50 books and pick a free book!
